ERA Points Update

Uniform Expectations

We understand that during lockdown, some pupils will have grown out of school uniform, school shoes and PE kit. After Easter, all pupils will be expected to attend school in the correct uniform and also have the correct PE kit. Please also remember that on the two days which KS3 are scheduled to have PE, pupils should attend school wearing their PE kit. A reminder that pupils are not permitted to wear hoodies/coats but can wear plain black tracksuit jackets (no hood) and additional layers underneath their PE tops. Whilst we are coming into spring, the weather can still be unpredictable and it is always better for pupils to bring lots of layers and not wear them, than not to bring them and be cold.

Having reviewed the weather, after Easter coats will not be worn in lessons, most children are doing this already but no coats in lessons will be an expectation after Easter. It is great to have the pupils back, so can we adhere to these expectations so the focus can remain on learning.
