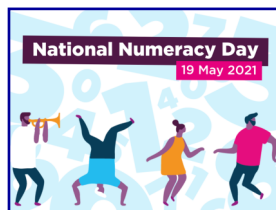

Monday 7th June: School re-opens at 8.30am after the half term holiday.

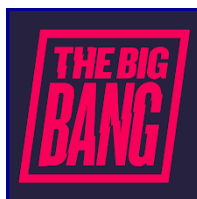
