Behaviour on Buses

Whilst we fully appreciate that the overwhelming majority of students behave in a way that reflects the academy values of Excellence, Resilience and Aspiration, a minority of students are behaving in an inappropriate manner. We are writing to you to highlight some concerns regarding a deterioration of behaviour on the school buses to and from Montsaye. This negative behaviour poses a significant health and safety risk; and is not fair on the other students on the buses or the drivers.

As an academy, we will follow our behaviour policy and any students found behaving in an inappropriate way will be sanctioned accordingly. North Northamptonshire Council also reserve the right to suspend or remove bus passes from students who behave in a manner that jeopardises the safety of other passengers or road users.

We will be reinforcing this message to all students who use school transport and liaising with North Northamptonshire council to address this issue, from today.

Please can we encourage you to speak to your child so that they do not lose their place on the buses.

We expect to see an improvement with immediate effect.
