Non-uniform day in aid of Save the Children

On Tuesday 19th December we will be raising money for the Save the Children Charity. This will be a full non-uniform day with the children wearing either a Christmas jumper, Christmas colours or Christmas sparkle.

Non-uniform should be appropriate for a school day. Please note: Christmas pyjamas and onesies are not allowed.

Suggested donation is £1 per student but please donate more if you feel able. Donations can be made via the Scopay app and students will also be able to donate cash on the day.

End of term

The school will close to all students at 12.30pm on Tuesday 19th December 2023 for the Christmas break. School buses will arrive for the earlier finish to ensure students are able to get home. If you are collecting your child or if they walk home, please plan accordingly. If your child has a free school meal, they will be able to collect this at breaktime on the day.

Return to school after the Christmas break

There is a staff training day across the Pathfinder Schools trust, which includes Montsaye Academy, on Wednesday 3rd January 2024. This means that all students are expected to return to school on Thursday 4th January 2024 in full uniform and they are to arrive by 8.35am. Buses will be running as normal.
