Tuesday 5th September 2023 - School open to pupils in all year groups

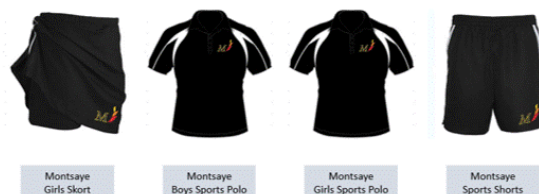
School day
