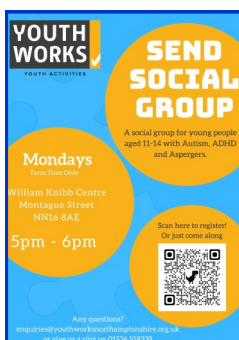
**Exciting Announcement - Next Year's School Production**
