Student Reception Opening Times and First Aid Information

We have changed how we operate our student reception and first aid procedures.

Student reception is now open: Before School: 8.30am to 8.40am Break Time: 10.48am to 11.03am Lunch Time: 1.26pm to 1.56pm After School: 3.00pm to 3.15pm

If your child feels ill during lesson time, they should tell their teacher. The teacher will email our first aider who will then go out to the classroom and assess your child. Your child will be accompanied back to student reception if if is deemed necessary. If your child needs help before school, at break, lunch or after school, student reception will be open at the times listed.
