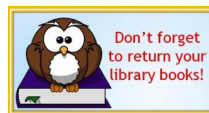
Year 6 into Year 7 Transition Day

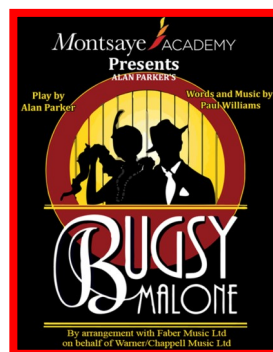
Uniform Grants for Families in the Farming Industry
