**Re: Risk Assessment Update**

I have reviewed the Risk Assessment again and am pleased to say that we are now in a position that Montsaye pupils no longer have to wear masks in school. We had put this measure in place in response to the high number of Covid-19 cases locally, but now that numbers have significantly reduced, it is no longer necessary. However, I do reserve the right to reinstate masks for pupils again should there be a subsequent rise in numbers.

By way of a reminder, we have the nursing team visiting the site on 19<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2021 to administer the 12-15 Covid-19 vaccine to pupils whose parents have given their consent via the online form that was previously shared.
