Due to government funding in the adult education budget, the AIM Group have several **Free Online Level 2 Accredited Courses** available to parents/carers. These help better understand some key issues around young people's mental health and wellbeing, along with a range of other qualifications which may help with developing careers. There are over 30 qualifications available with some of the most popular being 'Understanding Autism', 'Children and Young People's Mental Health' and a 'L3 Teaching Assistant Qualification'.
