Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 7 pupils have the opportunity to complete an experiment in one of their science lessons next week. They will be creating their own pH indicator in order to test various substances to determine whether they are acidic or alkaline. For this they will need some equipment (which they have been emailed) and it is essential that they have adult supervision as this experiment requires the use of a blender and handling bleach. If you do not own a blender then the red cabbage used in the experiment can be boiled to have the same effect.

If your child is unable to complete the practical as you do not have the equipment needed or supervision will not be available, this is not a problem as pupils will be able to watch their teacher complete this demonstration via Teams within the lesson. Pupils are more than welcome to complete this practical at a later date when adult supervision is available.

Pupils in X band will have their lesson on Tuesday during P4.

Pupils in Y band will have their lesson on Wednesday during P2.
