In two weeks' time, they will all sit down in the hall and see how many of the 100 facts they can recall which will show them how effective they have been at revising.

On Thursday evening, we welcomed the parents and carers of Year 11 students into school for a final information evening ahead of the GCSE examinations. We shared lots of tips for supporting your children with their revision and Mrs Mooney (Head of English), Mrs Sutliff (Head of Science) and Mr Darnbrook (Head of Maths) explained what to revise and where to go to find additional revision resources for each subject. It was great to see so many in attendance making the most of the opportunity to get some final advice and guidance.

With warmer weather coming we also opened the field to all year groups which they all appreciated. Year 7 and 8 still have their own designated areas on the bottom part of the field with Year 9, 10 and 11 sharing the top field. It was nice to see the children enjoying the weather and playing football and other games on the grass.
