I would like to thank you all for all your support and hard work with your children over the last five years and especially through Y10 and Y11 with the added stress and interruption caused by the global pandemic.

Results day this year will be a little earlier than in other years and will be on **Thursday, August 12th**. To minimise the number of students on site at any one time we ask students to collect their results at the following times:

Please do not arrive before the following times:

- Surnames A-D arrive between 9-9.30am
- Surnames E-M arrive 9.30-10am
- Surnames N-Z arrive between 10am-10.30am

Students should come to the main hall where there will be staff from the academy and the sixth form to offer advice and support. We will also be offering telephone support from the careers service as well, should this be needed. It is important to note that legally the results data belongs to the students so we cannot hand the results to anyone else, including parents, without the written permission of the students themselves. If they cannot come to school that day and would like results posted or emailed home please complete and return the [Results Permission Form](#) to the Exams Officer by Friday 23rd July 2021.

Due to social distancing rules in the Academy, only students can be in the school building, we would therefore ask parents to wait off-site as our driveway and car parks are being resurfaced. If you are picking up results on behalf a student please go to the main reception area.
