GO 4 Schools App

Please note that from September 2019 we will be using GO 4 Schools as the platform for setting, tracking and monitoring homework. The GO 4 Schools App allows you to view and check off homework with your child as it is completed. The Show My Homework App will no longer be used.

Using the GO 4 Schools App will enable you to view on your smartphone or tablet the following information and detail on your child: **timetable, homework, session attendance, behaviour and attainment.** The GO 4 Schools App will also send to your smartphone and/or email address summary notifications/emails.
