Your Commitment

- To attend 6 Full Governor meetings each academic year. These last approximately 2 hours each and you will be required to spend additional time before hand reading the papers provided.
- To attend sub-committees which meet 3-4 times a year, also for 2 hours.
- To participate on ad hoc committees that may be created for specific issues.
- To attend 2 standards meetings per academic year during school hours for your link department (each governor is allocated a link to a specific department/curriculum area).
- To carry out a governor monitoring visit to your designated department each academic year.
- To make less formal visits to your link department to gain a better understanding of how it operates and develop positive relationships.
- There are also many other community events and student events where your attendance would be welcomed.
- To attend new governor training course.
- To attend additional governing training when required.
- To complete on-line training modules as required.
