It is with pleasure that we welcomed her Majesty's inspector Deborah Mosely and Ofsted Inspector Matthew Sammy on the 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> of September 2018 on a monitoring visit and I am pleased to announce that they were exceptionally pleased with the progress that Montsaye Academy is making towards the removal of special measures. There are many highlights in the report, here are a few:

*"The Montsaye ERA (excellence, resilience, aspiration) values are now embedded and permeate through different aspects of the school."*

*"Pupils understand diversity and accept those who are different to themselves."*

*"Pupils' conduct in lessons and around school is good. They are polite and courteous."*

*"Pupils are proud to be members of the school. They recognise the improvements that have been made and that staff hold their interests at heart. Pupils have responded well to raised expectations of uniform, which they wear with pride. They have also responded positively to teachers' expectations of well-presented work."*
