

Montsaye Academy Peripatetic Music Provision 2025-26

Dear Parents/Carers,

Montsaye Academy currently offers a great range of peripatetic musical tuition and would like to offer your son/daughter the opportunity to continue or join this programme. Places are limited, therefore allocation is operated on a first come, first served basis. Students who have previously studied an instrument at Montsaye Academy or at their primary school will be given priority onto the scheme, upon receipt of a signed contract and deposit payment.

You may choose to pay for the entire year's tuition in advance or send a £35 deposit per instrument lesson, with this form and complete the direct debit mandate enclosed. Direct Debits will start on 1st October 2025. Please note there has been an increase in the price due to NMPAT increasing their cost.

Each student will receive a total of 33 lessons spread throughout the academic year and will receive a loan instrument from either the music service of the school where possible. All students are actively encouraged to regularly participate in at least one extra-curricular music group per week and is expected of those receiving fully subsidised or workshop lessons and those in receipt of a bursary.

These lessons are subject to availability as the validity relies on sufficient student numbers.

Due to the teaching methods, it is not possible to teach shared lessons for piano. Therefore, we are only able to offer individual lessons for piano tuition.

Students who currently receive **free school meals or are pupil premium** are invited to apply for a bursary to cover all or part of the cost of lessons. The deadline for bursary applications is 20th June 2025. Students who do not fall into this category, but still require financial support, may apply for assistance directly with the music service. Grants typically cover up to 50% of lesson fees. Forms are available at www.NMPAT.co.uk/Remissions.

All payments need to be directed to Montsaye Academy Finance Office. The preferred method of payment is direct debit. There will be 10 monthly direct debit payments, starting in October 2025. Please complete the attached direct debit mandate enclosed.

The Company shown on your bank statement for the Direct Debit will be CLUBWISE. There will be an additional charge if you cancel your direct debit without prior arrangement or if it is returned by the bank. Unfortunately, we can



no longer accept termly or ad-hoc part payment. If you wish to pay by cash or cheque, this must now be yearly in advance.

Please take the time to read the Instrumental Contract - Terms and Conditions before completing and then return the signed contract with deposit **by Friday 20th June 2025** as we must book the appropriate lesson time with the music service. Any forms that are not returned by the deadline will automatically be added to a waiting list.
