What to Bring

Food

All meals are provided at the Chateau and the centre will arrange for food for the return journey. Students may either need money to purchase food on the outward journey or being along a packed lunch. Special diets can be catered for, please include details on consent forms.

Medical

All students must be in possession of a European Health Insurance Card. **This must** be returned to the Academy by Friday 5th October the latest. Please ensure it is in an envelope with your child's name and form on it (these should be brought to student reception and placed in the box provided). This will enable some medical costs to be reimbursed under European Union reciprocal arrangements. A child will **not** be able to travel if we do not have their card prior to departure.

All students will be insured against accidents, injury and loss of personal items. All instructors based at Chateau are trained in First Aid. There is a twenty-four hour medical cover system at the centre provided by a team of duty instructors.

Depending on the type of medicine and preference of parents/carers, students can either self-medicate or these can be administered by staff.

<u>Accommodation</u>

Students will be accommodated in eight bedded ensuite rooms. Every effort will be made to room students in friendship groups.

Spending Money

Students should bring no more than £30 equivalent in euros and a small amount in sterling for the journey.

Customs

Students are not allowed to bring into the UK alcohol, tobacco products, items of an obscene nature, imitation firearms, knives and fireworks. The academy will not allow students to import cigarette lighters or laser pens. If a student is unsure about an item they should ask before purchasing.

Mobile Telephones, Electrical Equipment and Cameras

The Academy would prefer that mobile telephones are not brought on the trip, however, we recognise that students use these as their main camera. The Academy can accept no responsibility for the loss or damage of such items.

Students can bring cameras but again loss or damage will not be accepted by the Academy.

Chateau does not allow hair dryers and other such electrical items to be used by children on their site.
