This is an art technique used to create three dimensional illusions(giving depth and space) on a two dimensional surface which is flat like a piece of






One point perspective

A drawing method that shows how things appear to get smaller the further away you go. All lines converge at a single point on the horizon line called the vanishing point. It makes the drawing look three dimensional and realistic.








Buildings

Uses two vanishing points that are set well apart on the horizon line


