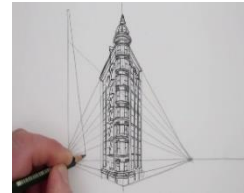

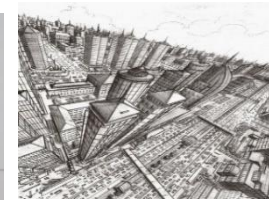
Using one, two and three point perspective drawing methods will help to create buildings and cityscapes with scale, depth and detail.
