In the meantime, we wanted to share again the plans put in place to support your learning at home.

Each of your subjects has come up with a learning plan that you can follow for this term – these plans follow the topics that will be covered in school for the weeks that you are at home. They may not be the exact same lessons, but the work set has been designed so that you do not fall behind with your studies whilst you are away. Many of our learning plans will guide you towards using the National Oak Academy resources by providing you the relevant website links to the topic areas you are studying in class. All of your work should be completed on paper and kept safe to hand in to your teachers when you return to school. If you are well enough to do so, please follow your normal timetable as far as possible, try to keep to the school day so that you don't get overwhelmed with too much work, and if you struggle, please let us know.

If you are unable to access the internet for any reason, and so can't access this work, then you need to call school as soon as possible and let your progress leader know so that they are able to contact you and support you in accessing work in other ways. The school number is 01536 418844.
