I wrote to you in January to keep you up to date with changes in Montsaye Community Learning Partnership (MCLP). Since then there have been some significant appointments which we would like to ensure you are aware of and some impressive OFSTED results.

As I'm sure you are aware, Montsaye Academy was visited by OFSTED in January and was not only removed from Special Measures but achieved a 'GOOD' OFSTED rating. Both Montsaye and MCLP have been praised by the Department for Education for their rapid and determined work to ensure that the quality of education has improved so dramatically and with such urgency. In addition, both Rothwell Junior School and Rushton Primary School have been visited by OFSTED and achieved 'GOOD' OFSTED ratings during their one day inspections. Once again praise from the Department for Education has been forthcoming, as MCLP is rapidly becoming one of the highest performing academy trusts in Northamptonshire with all schools graded good or outstanding.

As with all forward thinking organisations we continue to move forward. At the Rothwell Schools Mr Hurling, Executive Head Teacher, is retiring at the end of May; we have been working hard to ensure that a successor is in place to ensure that the good level of education that both schools provide is maintained and we are delighted to announce that, following a rigorous recruitment process, Mr Izzard-Snape, currently Head Teacher of Loatlands Primary, will be taking on the Executive Headship. This of course means that Loatlands Primary will be looking for a replacement Head Teacher; once again we will waste no time to ensure that his successor is appointed in readiness for the new school year. We will of course keep you updated.

At the Havelock Schools we have been through a similar process to recruit a replacement Executive Head Teacher as I step up to take on the role of full time CEO of the organisation from September 2019. Once again we are thrilled to announce that Mrs Kiziak, currently Deputy Head of the two schools, was successful in securing the role.

I am privileged to continue working with Mr Izzard-Snape and Mrs Kiziak in their new roles and know that the standard of education in our MCLP schools will carry on improving in their very capable hands.
