

## SEND and Inclusion

The Montsaye Inclusion Team is dedicated to supporting every student, regardless of their special educational needs or disability, to be happy, safe, and excel at school. We have an established Inclusion area within the school, where we run interventions, break/lunch clubs, key worker meetings, and homework clubs, to name a few, and it is where our team is based. We take pride in getting to know our students well, from their academic strengths to their out-of-school achievements and everything in between.

We work with our students and parents to identify barriers and discuss how we can support children, both in and out of the classroom. We liaise regularly with external agencies, fostering strong links with key stakeholders, with the student at the heart of everything we do.

Our Learning Support Assistants (LSAs) provide inclass support to identified students, in addition to running a range of interventions related to communication, cognitive, social, emotional, sensory, and physical needs.

We have our own ELSA (Emotional Literacy Support Assistant), who runs additional interventions to support children in recognising, understanding, and managing their emotions.

The school values underpin all that the Inclusion Team do at Montsaye, advocating and supporting children throughout their educational journey.





## How to Apply For A Place at Montsaye Academy

You can make an application for a place at Montsaye Academy for September 2026 if your child is in Year 6 at primary school and has their 11th birthday between 1st September 2025 and 31st August 2026.

If your child is already at secondary school and wishes to move to Montsaye, you will need to make an <u>in-year application</u>.
