What will you find in the SIMS Parent/Carer app:

- Access to update your contact details, so that we always have the most up-to-date information in case of emergency.
- If you have more than one child at school, you will have access to information for all your children, from the same app.

Getting started with the SIMS Parent/Carer app:

- We will send you an activation email, simply click on the link below from your tablet, PC or smartphone to activate your account. Please ensure that we have been given your most up to date email address in order for you to receive your activation link.
- You can then login using your normal **Facebook, Twitter, Google** or **Microsoft** username and password.
- From your smartphone or tablet, download the app from the Google Play or Apple App store search for **SIMS**Parent.
- From a PC or Windows phone, login online at www.sims-parent.co.uk

Your activation email will expire after 14 days if it is not used, please contact us at school if you require a replacement after this date.
