New SIMS Parent/Carer App



We have a convenient new way to update the data we hold on you in our database. Parents/carers will be able to access our new app and website. They can be accessed from a smartphone, tablet or PC – anytime, anywhere. What will you find in the SIMS Parent/Carer app:

- Access to update your contact details, so that we always have the most up-to-date information in case of emergency.
- If you have more than one child at school, you will have access to information for all your children, from the same app.

Getting started with the SIMS Parent/Carer app:

- We will send you an activation email, simply click on the link below from your tablet, PC or smartphone to
 activate your account. Please ensure that we have been given your most up to date email address in order
 for you to receive your activation link.
- You can then log in using your normal Facebook, Twitter, Google or Microsoft username and password.
- From your smartphone or tablet, download the app from the Google Play or Apple App store search for **SIMS Parent.**
- From a PC or Windows phone, login online at <u>www.sims-parent.co.uk</u>

Please note that your activation email is unique to you and should not be used by anyone else. If you require an additional login then please contact us at school. Your activation email will expire after 14 days if it is not used, please contact us at school if you require a replacement after this date.
