Collection of Exam Results

We invite candidates to collect their exam results from the main hall between 9.00am and 11.00am on the following dates: **A-level** Thursday 15th August and **GCSE** Thursday 22nd August.

Teaching staff will be available to provide support and advice for students. For those students who are unable to attend, we are able to post the results home; for this purpose, please provide a stamped addressed envelope to reception or the exams office **by Thursday 11th July**.

Alternatively, a letter of authorisation may be written from students allowing someone else to collect their results on their behalf. The letter must include the full name of the nominated person and their relationship to the student, as well as the student's full name and signature, and be delivered to reception or the exams office by Thursday 11th July. The identified third party will be required to provide photo ID and sign to confirm their receipt of the results. Results belong to the candidate and therefore, a letter of authority from a parent will not be acceptable; the letter must come from the candidate.
