At Montsaye Academy, we encourage, value and reward good attendance. Research shows that good attendance goes hand-in-hand with good progress and examination results. We monitor your child's attendance rate regularly and, as a trust, all schools will send students a termly (three times a year) attendance letter with the aim of celebrating good and improving attendance. We do ask that, where possible, parents try to make dentist and doctor appointments outside of school hours.
