#### **Exam Results**

We invite candidates to collect their exam results from the main hall between 9.00-11.00am on the following dates:

**A-level:** Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> August **GCSE:** Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> August.

Teaching staff will be available to provide support and advice for students. For those who are unable to attend, we are able to post the results home; for this purpose, please provide a stamped addressed envelope to reception by Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> July.

Alternatively, a letter of authorisation may be written from students allowing someone else to collect their results on their behalf. It must include the full name of the nominated person and their relationship to the student, as well as the student's full name and signature. The identified third party must bring this letter to the results collection session and they will be required to provide photo ID and sign to confirm their receipt of the results. Results belong to the candidate and therefore, a letter of authority from a parent will not be acceptable; the letter must come from the candidate. Monday 3rd and Tuesday 4th September 2018: staff training days. School closed to all students.

## Uniform

Please be reminded that formal flat black shoes will be school uniform regulation as of September 2018. Trainers and fabric shoes will not be allowed. Also from September, students in Years 7 to 9 will wear the grey uniform, while those in Years 10 and 11 will continue to wear black.

#### Parking on the school grounds

We ask that you do not park on the double yellow lines anywhere on the school premises, including on the roundabout near our main reception and alongside the swimming pool. Please use the designated parking bays in the school car park. This is causing particular problems at 3.00pm when we have lots of students moving around the site and a large number of buses to accommodate. With effect from 1st September, we will be asking parents to move if we see that cars are being parked on the double yellow lines. Please also refrain from parking in the disabled bays unless of course you are a Blue Badger holder.

We also ask that you observe the 5mph speed limit whilst driving on the school premises.
