Uniform

Please be reminded that formal flat black shoes will be school uniform regulation as of September 2018. Trainers and fabric shoes will not be allowed. Also from September, students in Years 7 to 9 will wear the grey uniform, while those in Years 10 and 11 continue to wear black.

Parking on the school grounds

We ask that you do not park on the double yellow lines anywhere on the school premises, including on the roundabout near our main reception and alongside the swimming pool. Please use the designated parks bays in the school car park. This is causing particular problems at 3.00pm when we have lots of students moving around the site and a large number of buses to accommodate. With effect from 1st September, we will be asking parents to move if we see that cars are being parked on the double yellow lines.
