Update on 14th of May 2021

In line with government guidance, from the 17th of May 2021 masks are no longer required in schools for pupils, although staff will wear them in communal areas/meetings. Staff wearing them in lessons will be left to personal preference.

Importantly, the guidance also says that, *“The reintroduction of face coverings for pupils, pupils or staff may be advised for a temporary period in response to particular localised outbreaks, including variants of concern.”* We will continue to monitor this and advise parents/staff as appropriate if the situation changes.

All other Risk Assessment stipulations remain in place.
