Montsaye Academy Sixth Form Entry Requirements

Thresholds based upon the number and type of Level 2 course results

Pathway 1 -students with six GCSE grades 7 or above will be able to choose four subjects.

Pathway 2 -students with six GSCE grades 5 or above will be able to choose three subjects providing they meet the subject criteria.

Pathway 3 -students with six GCSE grades 4 or above must choose at least one level 3 vocational course (ICT, Health and Social Care, Sport and Physical, Dance, Music, Drama)

Subject specific criteria: Students will have achieved at least grade 5 at GCSE in any subject they intend to study at A Level. Students may be able to study an A Level subject they did not take at GCSE, if they meet other entry criteria. If this situation arises, then students will be expected to complete a bridging unit over the summer, after the GCSE examinations, or as soon as possible after their choice has been made.
