<p>Cultural Capital</p>	<p>Pétanque is a traditional French games It is open for all ages and is used as a reason to get out and socialise. The focal point of each town/village is the "bouledrome", especially in southern France. The aim of the game being to throw your steel "boule" to get as close to the small object ball (the "cochonnet"). The closest to this, wins.</p>
