Keyword	Definition
The Treaty of Versailles	The treaty that formally ended World War 1.
The Rhineland	A part of Germany on the border with France.
War Guilt Clause	Part of the Treaty of Versailles. Germany had to take the blame for causing World War One.
Fascism	A kind of government, in which a dictator runs everything, no-one gets to vote and the military is seen as very important.
Reparations	A huge amount of money that Germany had to pay to other countries as punishment for World War One.
The League of Nations	A first attempt at the UN. An organisation designed to keep world peace.
Rationing	Carefully controlling how much you eat, so you don't run out of food.
Munitions	Military weapons and ammunition.

Explain why Hitler was unable to “break” Britain.
