



- The youth are called Ga Ga Kids and they are compelled to watch the same movies, listen to computer-generated music, wear the same clothes and hold the same thoughts and opinions.
- Musical instruments are forbidden, and rock music is unknown.
- A bunch of Bohemians are looking for the 'Rhapsody' in the rocky rubble of Tottenham Court Tube Station. 

Task 2: Set Design.





- Select a scene from the show (page 56, scene 8 looks interesting see below). Design and plan out a set for the actors to perform within.
 What is the environment of the scene? (read the synopsis above) is it in a city, in the countryside? You need to understand <u>where</u> and <u>when</u> We Will Rock You is set.
- Consider the back drop (the scene at the back of the stage) and screens (these are called flats in the theatre) painted or constructed towards the side of the stage. Look at existing set designs to help you.









ACT 1, Scene 8 The Hard Rock Café.

(There are a few tables/stools...the place is filled with broken, faded Rock memorabilia--faded rock posters, washing lines of clothes and costumes and broken gold discs...there are also larger artifacts--a rusting old Harley, a cracked TV and a smashed up juke box...as the song ends the joint is filled with more BOHEMIANS, crazy rock rebels like BRIT and OZ dressed in every confusion of ancient rock styles and iconic costume.)


- 2. Design costumes for the characters you find most interesting.















- 4. Label you designs discussing the fabrics you would use and why it would be suitable for the character.

Task 4: Face paint designs for the Bohemians.

- In the show The Bohemians are a group of people who are fighting to restore the freedom of thought, fashion, and live music in a distant future where everyone dresses, thinks and acts the same. Produce a range of designs to be painted on to the actors faces. Use the templates to help.
- Keep colours and shapes simple so they can be applied quickly.









Task 5: Hair and Makeup

• Read about the characters and select 2 or 3 who you would like to produce designs for their hair and makeup, remember it must be representative of their character in the show and tie in with your costume design!

• Some people may want to experiment with their own hair and makeup or find a willing volunteer? and try to recreate some of these looks! Remember if you are on stage your designs need to be bright to show up for the audience! Take a photograph of your creations

Task 6: Props









- Plan and create props for the actors to work with during the show. Think about how you would construct them? What will they be made from? People may need to sing and dance with them so they need to be light but durable.
